### Writing in Color

The Writing in Color program is designed to connect writers of color with their peers in order to share work, ideas, inspiration, and resources—all with the goal of creating a more diverse, equitable, and inclusive writing community. The program aims to increase visibility and publication for its participants and more broadly support fuller representation in literature.

### Writing in Color Retreat July 28-August 1, 2019

This annual retreat invites writers of color to beautiful Allenspark, Colorado (near Rocky Mountain National Park) for four days of workshops, writing, and community. Writers will work closely with experienced guest faculty representing a variety of genres. Workshops will focus on the creation of new works and connecting that work to social movements and larger audiences. Writers of color over the age of 21 are eligible. The deadline to apply is April 15, 2019.



## Writing in Color Fellowship for Emerging Writers

This fellowship is offered annually to a writer of color who would benefit from a year's worth of membership, classes, and involvement at Lighthouse but needs financial support to do so. Applicants should demonstrate a passion for writing, an interest in developing their writing skills, and a clear commitment to community service. Writers of color who live in Colorado, are over the age of 21, and have not yet published a full-length manuscript are eligible. The deadline to apply is April 1, 2019.

## Writing in Color Monthly Mixer

Writing in Color meets at Lighthouse's Denver headquarters the third Friday of every month, from 5:30 to 7:30 PM. The first hour is dedicated to catching up over drinks and light snacks; the second hour introduces specific programming, such as panelists, themed discussions, tutorials, and more. These events are free and open to all writers of color.
